Dear Parents

Looking ahead to the 11+ examination, which this year falls on Saturday, 9th September 2017, I was keen to share with you how the school will prepare the pupils for this important day.

Firstly, on Thursday 6th July 2017, Mr Morgans will be offering a Study Skills session for Year 5 pupils, which looks at strategies for examination success, time-keeping and preparation techniques for the holiday period.

During the first few days of school, Thursday 7th & 8th September, we will be offering drop-in workshops in case the pupils have any particular areas they wish to work on with a teacher. Please also note that both Mr Morgans, as well as Mr Champs, will be available for advice upon request.

A pack of practice exercises will also be provided over the holiday period by Mr Champs and Mr Morgans, but please also note that Extra Tuition runs on Mondays and Tuesdays at school through the Summer holidays and further details can be found on our website or via Miss Thorpe, the school Receptionist.

As this year, the school returns on Thursday 7th September, a little later in the week than our usual calendar date, we are offering revision sessions for Year 6 pupils on Tuesday 5th and Wednesday 6th September between the hours of 1.30pm-3.30pm. Please could you kindly complete the slip below if you would like your son or daughter to attend these sessions which will be run by Mr Morgans, in close association with Mr Champs to cover the key areas of mathematics, comprehension, VR and NVR. Please note that there is no ASC on either day and that full school uniform should be worn on both days.

Our timetable in the days running up to the examination will be entirely geared towards exam preparation in order that the pupils may feel fully reassured about what to expect, but we will also ensure that timetabling allows an opportunity to release some energy through PE/Games sessions.

Our aim is to provide excellent preparation for this important examination and, in so doing, allows pupils and parents both peace of mind and a positive approach which takes the pressure off at this crucial time.
