Monthly Fee

- The monthly fee is invoiced and payable monthly in advance. It is calculated by taking the weekly cost of the sessions booked, multiplying that amount by 52 (weeks) and then dividing by 12 (months). The calculation takes no account of Bank or Public Holidays.
- The monthly fee includes all meals and refreshments (including formula milk) applicable to the hours of your child's attendance, as well as any nappies required by your child whilst at the nursery.
- It must be paid by bank transfer, standing order or voucher in cleared funds before the calendar month to which it relates.
- Please note that we may need to calculate the fees differently for certain months:
 - if your child starts or leaves part way through a month; and
 - where the sessions attended change part way through

For these months you will be charged for each session at the sessional rate.

Additional Fees and Charges

- Additional fees and charges arising in a particular month will be added to the following month's invoice.
- If you book sessions in addition to the agreed booking pattern in a particular month you will be charged for these at the sessional rate.
- Occasionally, the nursery will organise activities or day trips which incur an additional charge. You will be consulted about such charges.
- Other charges may be imposed for late payment of fees and late collection of children. Please see clauses 4.7 and 4.8 of the Nursery's terms and conditions.

Discounts

- Where two siblings attend the Nursery simultaneously, the monthly fee for the older child will be discounted by 7%.
 Where more than two siblings attend the Nursery simultaneously, the monthly fee for the eldest child will be discounted by 7%, but whether and to what extent any further discount should apply will be determined by the Senior Nursery Manager in the exercise of her absolute discretion.
- Where siblings attend the Nursery and Norfolk House School simultaneously, the nature and extent of any discount in the respective fees will be determined by agreement between the Senior Nursery Manager and the Headmistress in the exercise of their absolute discretion.

Childcare Vouchers

 Childcare vouchers are an employee benefit for all eligible working parents. They are a government approved, taxefficient way of paying for childcare. Whilst the nursery accepts vouchers as payment, it does not have any contractual relationship with the company which issues the vouchers or the parent's employer which would enable it to enforce payment. It is therefore the responsibility of parents to ensure that voucher payments reach the nursery in accordance with its terms and conditions.

Early Education Entitlement

- All parents and carers of 3 and 4-year-olds are entitled to up to 15 hours of early education over 38 weeks of the year with a registered childcare provider. Eligible working parents and carers of children aged 3-4 can also get an additional 15 hours childcare support, bringing their total up to 30 hours a week over 38 weeks of the year.
- Eligible working parents of 2-year-olds may also be able to access 15 hours childcare support over 38 weeks of the
- Eligible parents of 2-year-old children may also be entitled to 15 hours childcare support, if they receive some additional forms of government support.

Upcoming Changes

- From September 2024, 15 hours childcare support will be extended to eligible working parents of children from the age of 9 months to 3-year-olds.
- From September 2025, eligible working parents with a child from 9 months old up to school age will be entitled to 30 hours of childcare a week.

How the funding is delivered to parents

- At Norfolk House Nursery we stretch the funded hours across 52 weeks with deductions being made from your monthly invoice.
- Funded only attendance is limited to the Universal Entitlement (15 hours) and is subject to availability. It is offered Monday to Friday, 1pm-4pm, term time only.
